Dr. Annette Shideler, the interim Director of the TESOL Education Program at SUNY Stony Brook, will present a full day event for teachers who serve English Language Learners in mainstream settings.

With good reason, few teachers feel prepared for the unique needs of English Language Learners (ELLs) in their mainstream classrooms. These students pose demands not addressed in regular teacher training programs.

English Language Learners pose unique challenges in our mainstream classes. This full day and VERY hands-on workshop will focus on analyzing data to determine areas in ELA curriculum particularly difficult for ELL students.
